**May 14th 2018: Sharon Hart-Green:Tragedy and Healing/Joanna Charnas:Managing Illness**

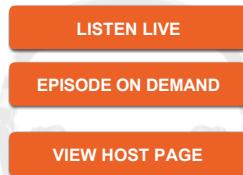

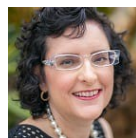
