**March 6th 2024: PART 2: SAFETY & SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY - JOURNALISM AND TRAUMA**

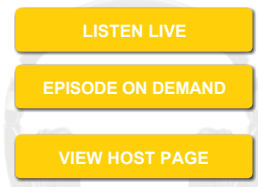

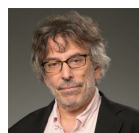

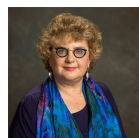
